

IINET TO PROVIDE UNMETERED DOWNLOADS ON ITUNES

24 April 2007– iiNet Limited Chief Operating Officer, Mark White, announced today an exclusive arrangement where iiNet members can download music and video files purchased from iTunes without affecting their monthly download quota.

Mark White said the ability to download from iTunes without affecting monthly quota limits would be an exciting prospect for any current or future iiNet member.

“In the past five years, customers have mostly moved their dial up habits on to broadband, so they’ve been using email, web browsing and using online banking” said Mr White. “As the take up of high speed broadband has increased, we’re now seeing our customers trying out new types of media, like music and video.”

“Naturally we want to support our members in gaining access to the current and future content that services like iTunes provide.”

iiNet currently has the largest number of ADSL2+ subscribers in Australia having established its own independent high-speed broadband network in 2004.

Mr White also announced the creation of a new team to provide technical support to Macintosh users.

“iiNet has always been very proud to support Mac users,” said Mr White. “We’re now setting up a team that will be vendor trained and focussed on handling the growing number of customers we are seeing who are using Macs.”

The new team is expected to be available by the end of May and will be available during weekdays. Outside of these hours, support will still be available 24x7 from the general support line.
